Weigh-Ins :

Friday, April 4<sup>th</sup>

2:00 – 4:00 p.m. S.B.- Elite. 5:00 – 9:00 p.m. Tot-Novice

The  $\frac{1}{2}$  pound rule will apply for all weigh-ins. This means that if you are  $\frac{1}{2}$  pound or less over, you will be allowed to lose this weight and weigh again. If you are over  $\frac{1}{2}$  pound above the weight class, you will not be allowed to weigh again. You will be allowed to challenge one other scale.

Wrestlers MUST weigh in with a singlet.

No Saturday morning weigh-ins.

Wrestling Begins:

Ages: Tot – Elite

Awards: Individual Medals  $1^{st} - 6^{th}$ ; Large, Medium, Small Team Trophies  $1^{st} - 3^{rd}$ ; Ten-man Trophies  $1^{st} - 3^{rd}$ ; Traveling Trophy; Outstanding Wrestler and Quick Pin Awards for each division.

Entry Fee: \$12.00 per wrestler. Copy of birth certificate and current AAU card are required for all wrestlers. No Club checks will be accepted .

Admission:Adult \$10.00Student \$6.00 weekend pass.Adult \$6.00 & student \$4.00 daily.Passes will be for sale on Friday. Coaches will be responsible to pay<br/>admission fee and will be reimbursed at end of tournament through your Head Club Coach/Treasurer.

Coaches: Coaches passes will be handed out Friday evening and Saturday morning. Coach's passes cost \$15.00 which gets you on the floor and into the hospitality room.

Each coach must have an AAU card and have proof that they have passed the CURRENT PCA coaches class available online at aausports.org. This class is mandatory to coach on the floor at the state tournament and your card must be dated 2014. Each coach must also have taken the MTWOA Rules Clinic given at various locations across the state. There will be a MTWOA Clinic held Friday at 5p.m. for the cost of \$10.

EACH HEAD COACH FROM EACH CLUB WILL NEED TO SUBMIT A LIST OF COACHES THAT WILL BE ON THE FLOOR COACHING TO US BY APRIL 2<sup>ND</sup>. IF YOU ARE NOT ON THE LIST, YOU WILL NOT BE ISSUED A PASS. NO EXCEPTIONS. ALL COACHES ARE REQUIRED TO HAVE THE FOLLOWING: UPDATED PCA COACH'S CARD, 2014 AAU MEMBERSHIP CARD & THE MTWOA RULES CLINIC CARD. COACHES PLEASE SUBMIT YOUR COACHING ROSTER ALONG WITH AN ELECTRONIC COPY (OR PHOTO) OF ALL 3 REQUIRED DOCUMENTS TO BOTH OF THE FOLLOWING PEOPLE BY 7 PM APRIL 2<sup>ND</sup>, 2014. THIS WILL EXPEDITE THE PROCESS OF HANDING OUT PASSES, YOU WILL NOT HAVE TO WAIT IN LINE AS LONG. EACH TEAM WILL BE REFUNDED 1 COACH'S PASS FEE FOR EVERY 10 WRESTLERS. A CHECK WILL BE MAILED OUT FOLLOWING THE TOURNAMENT. IF YOU ARE COACHING AS AN INDEPENDENT, YOU WILL STILL NEED ALL OF THE PREVIOUS CREDENTIALS, AND YOU WILL NEED TO CONTACT US TO GET ON THE ROSTER.

If you do not get your coaches pass until Saturday, coaches will pay the \$10 admission fee at the gate. You will then only be charged \$5 for your coach's band.
